## Inspiration

### Mark Zuckerberg

The founder and CEO of facebook; Mark Elliot Zuckerberg was born on May 14, 1984 in New York from his dentist father and his mother who is a psychiatrist. He is the only son for his family.

Mark got interested in programming yet in elementary school. He was taught Atari BASIC Programming by his father, and at the age of 12, he used Atari BASIC to create a messenger, which he called "ZuckNet." His father installed "ZuckNet" messenger on his computer in his dentist office, and the receptionist could inform him when a new patient arrived.

Also being at high school, Mark wrote an artificially intelligent media player Synapse for MP3-playlists that carefully studied the preferences of a user and was able to generate playlists 'guessing,' which tracks a user wanted to listen to.

In 2002, entered Harvard University. By his second year in the Ivy League, he had gained a reputation as a software developer on campus and he wrote a program CourseMatch, which helped students choose their subjects on the basis of lists of courses from other users.

In 2003, he got an idea to create a site called FaceMash that let students select the best looking person from a choice of photos.



On February 04, 2004, Mark Zuckerberg registered the domain name The Facebook.com, now known throughout the world as Facebook.com. However, it functioned only within Harvard. Later the facebook is made open for all students to get registered and became number one social network media on the world.

On May 19, 2012, Mark Zuckerberg married his longtime girlfriend Priscilla Chan and finally they happily live together.

His net worth is estimated to be US \$53.6 billion as of 2017, ranking him the 5th richest person in the world. <https://astrumpeople.com>
